Chapter 102 Program

- Minimize potential for accelerated erosion and sedimentation
 - Accelerated erosion ≠ erosion
- Manage post-construction stormwater
- Protect, maintain, reclaim and restore water quality and existing and designated uses



Relationship

- DEP and CCDs work together on the same team
- DEP delegates authority to CCDs through the Delegation Agreement
- EPA delegates authority to DEP through an agreement for the NPDES Program



Delegation Agreements

- Levels I, II, & III
- Post-Construction Stormwater Management
- Duties and Responsibilities
 - District
 - DEP Central Office
 - DEP Regional Office
- Required Output Measures



GreenPort Reporting

- Required by Delegation Agreement
- Create an account
- Information used for various reasons
- Must be accurate

PRP/PDG Policy

- Applicable to all of DEP and delegated Districts
- Process to review all permit applications
- PDG for specific permits
 - Chapter 102 Individual NPDES Permit
 - Chapter 102 ESCGP
- SOPs further define steps

- Stay up to date on program guidance
- Sign permit authorization letters and cover pages
- Know the Delegation Agreement
