


Level 2 Plan Approval Report – Attachment F



Level 2 Plan Approval Report – Attachment F

- CD should enter the NMP in the PracticeKeeper Database (PK)
 after the plan is board approved.
 - It may be entered sooner.
- Report should be saved for CD records, but does it is not required to be submitted to DEP or the SCC.



Level 2 Plan Approval Report – Attachment F

How the data is used:

- Aggregate and report number of active NMPs
- Aggregate and report number of animals/animal type and the amount of manure generated
- Aggregate and report manure transfers outside the county of origin and CB watershed
- Aggregate and report existing manure storages (planned)
- Geospatial data used to track compliance with planning and implementation of NMPs.





Opportunities

- Standard Reports can inform managers and staff of the work completed and encourage staff accountability.
- Data Explorer reports can inform a quantitative evaluation of any information recorded in PK.
 - Hot spots (Watersheds/townships) of work completed
 - funding source trends
- Spatial data can inform a targeted approach to outreach, implementation, or verification efforts.




BMP Funding Source

Number of implemented BMPs with an implemented date, implemented amount, and funding source identified.



Number of BMPs by Township




